Submission Requirements

- An essay in the size of up to 3 pages, two-column, prepared in line with the IEEE Paper Template, and
- 3-min video recorded elevator pitch; the inclusion of rich presentation slides, animations and of any other visual effects is encouraged.

Helpful Guidelines

Write an opener to catch the attention; Highlight the idea; By telling a story communicate your excitement and enthusiasm; In the summary section re-state a quality step change that the implementation of your vision & idea(s) will bring to the society and spell out the main takeaway from reading your essay.

Judging Criteria

20% - Does the essay explain the significance of the idea?

20% - Does it describe the future transport concept and product & services with clarity?

20% - Is it free from unexplained terms?

20% - Is it motivational and engaging?

20% - Is a video-recorded elevator pitch engaging?
